

Any exterior change or addition requires a miscellaneous permit:

- Exterior painting if the color changes
- New roof, if the color changes
- Siding, if color or material changes
- Deck or patio addition or extension
- Screen in existing deck or patio
- Enclose screened deck or patio
- Driveway extension or material change
- Garage extension; detached garage
- Retaining walls over 2 feet in height
- Landscape structures such as waterfalls, ponds, pergolas, arbors
- Fencing
- Flag pole
- Swimming pool (in ground only)
- Playground equipment if in excess of 30 square feet
- Solar panels
- Sidewalks

A permit is not required if maintenance being done uses the same materials and colors; the key is **CHANGE**.

The fee schedule is on the last page of the miscellaneous permit application.

All permit applications are on the POA website, under the ACC option on the homepage.
