The Highway Safety Committee has been very busy this summer meeting with local politicians regarding safety improvements for the Niles Ferry Road and State Route 411 intersection, attending the Lenoir City TDOT Construction Progress meetings for Highway 321 improvements, expressing our displeasure with the lack of progress on the Highway 11/321 intersection, and identifying trees along 444 that had fallen or were in immediate danger of falling so that TDOT crews could remove. And in August, seven streetlights are scheduled to be installed at the inter-section of Tellico Parkway and State Route 72. Thank you Henry Cullen for your assistance in getting these lights to improve road safety.
